1. INTRODUCTION

AAW Group Holdings Pty Ltd and its subsidiaries (“AAW Group”, “we”, “us”, or “our”) are committed to protecting your privacy and ensuring transparency in how we collect and use personal information. 2. WHAT ARE COOKIES?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device when you visit a website. They help websites remember your preferences, improve performance, and deliver personalised content. Cookies may be set by us (first-party cookies) or by third-party providers (third-party cookies).

3. TYPES OF COOKIES WE USE

We use only two categories of cookies on our website:

3.1. Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the website to function properly. They enable basic features such as secure access, page navigation, and form handling. Without these cookies, the website may not perform as intended. These cookies are always active and cannot be disabled.

3.2. Performance/Analytics Cookies

These cookies help us understand how visitors interact with our website by collecting anonymous usage data. This allows us to improve site performance and user experience. You can choose to enable or disable these cookies via browser settings.

3.3. Third-Party Cookies and Cross-Border Handling

Some cookies may involve third-party services hosted outside Australia or New Zealand. We take reasonable steps to ensure that any personal information collected via these cookies is handled securely and in accordance with applicable privacy laws, including the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and the Privacy Act 2020 (NZ). These third-party cookies are subject to the privacy policies of the respective service providers.

4. MANAGING YOUR COOKIE PREFERENCES

You can manage or disable your cookie preferences at any time via your browser settings. Please note that disabling necessary cookies may affect the functionality of our website.

5. LEGAL COMPLIANCE

This policy complies with the Privacy Act 1988 (Cth) and the Australian Privacy Principles (APPs), as well as the New Zealand Privacy Act 2020 and its Information Privacy Principles (IPPs). While explicit consent via pop-ups is not strictly required under Australian law, and not specifically mandated under New Zealand law, we follow best practice by providing clear disclosures and opt-out mechanisms for non-essential cookies.
